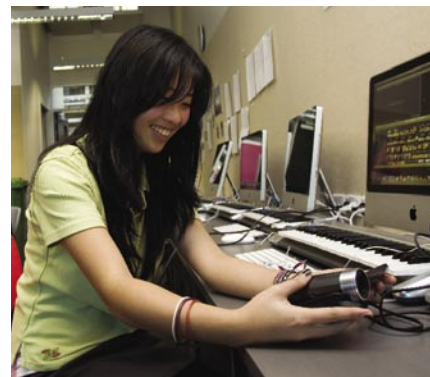

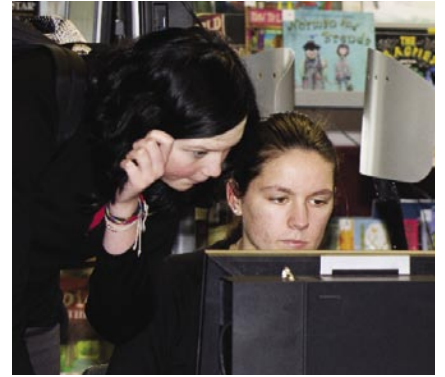

Good luck with making your subject choices, the decisions you make are very important. My advice is - consider carefully, seek advice if you need to and choose wisely.

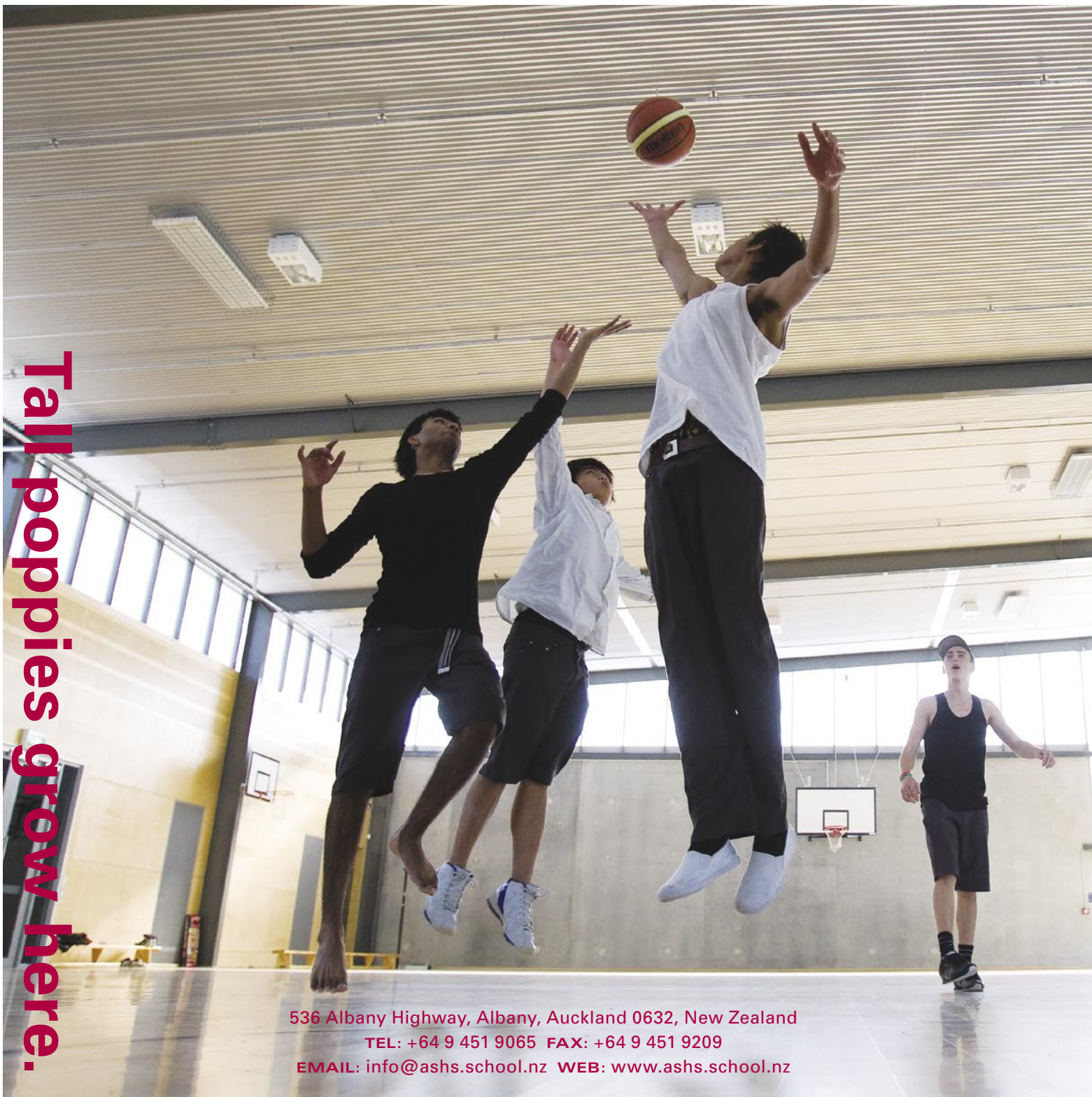
